Chapter 4 of the Municipal Systems Act, Act No. 32 of 2000, stipulates that a municipality must develop a culture of municipal governance that complements formal representative governance and must for this purpose encourage and create conditions for the local community to participate in the affairs of the Municipality, including in the preparation, implementation and review of its Integrated Development Plan in terms of Chapter 5. As part of the Municipal Integrated Development Plan in terms of the Municipal Systems Act, minor amendments to the Municipal Spatial Development Framework (2015) are to be included in the public participation process.

During the period from **Monday, 08 April to Wednesday, 17 April 2019** the Municipality will be conducting a series of public meetings on its 2019 Integrated Development Plan (IDP), Budget, Municipal Spatial Development Framework (MSDF) and Annual Report.

All residents of the Nelson Mandela Bay, including Stakeholders, Civil Society, Government Departments and Parastatals, are encouraged to participate in these meetings in order to improve development and service delivery in Nelson Mandela Bay. These public consultations will be led by the Executive Mayor and the Mayoral Committee.
